### **CATEGORY 1: CLASS III to V**

#### **1. HANDMADE HAVEN (CRAFT)(10.00am to 11.00am)**

##### **THEME: ANIMAL FACE MASK, FLOWER VASE, FINGER PUPPET**

- Participants must make the crafts based on the given theme or anything related to it
- Time limit :1 hour.
- Participants should bring their own materials.
- Participants can choose any one of the themes.

#### **2. SCRIBBLE STUDIO (DRAWING) (10.00am to 11.00am)**

##### **THEME: DIFFERENT TYPES OF FESTIVALS**

- Participants must draw based on the theme or anything related to it.
- Tracing of pictures or models not allowed.
- Draw any one festival
- Time limit :1 hour.
- **Participants should bring their own materials, only charts will be provided.**

#### **3. VEDIC VIBES (SLOKA) (11.00am to 12.00pm)**

##### **SLOKAS: GANESHA PANCHARATNAM, KRISHNASHTAKAM**

- Participants must prepare both Slokas.
- Judges will initiate any of the Slokas, which has to be continued by the Participants.
- Should memorize and chant.

#### **4. TALE WEAVERS (STORY TELLING) (10.00am to 11.00am)**

- **TOPIC:** Super heroes in magical lands (English/Tamil)
- Participants shall tell any stories related to the topic given.
- The story must be completed within the given time limit (3 Minutes).

#### **5.COSTUME CARNIVAL (FANCY DRESS) (11.00am to 12.00pm)**

- **TOPIC:** Super heroes\princess (No cinema personalities)
- Participants are asked to wear a suitable costume based on the given topic.
- Hazardous materials are prohibited
- Time limit allowed is 3 minutes.

### **1. VOCAL QUEST (MUSIC) (10.00am to 11.30am)**

#### **a) SOLO: Devotional songs**

- Participants must bring their own Shruthi Box.
- Cine songs are not allowed
- Reference to the lyrics is not permitted.
- Duration: 4 Minutes.
- Karaoke is not allowed.

#### **b) GROUP: Patriotic or Motivational Songs**

- A team can consist maximum of 3 members.
- Cine songs are not allowed
- Reference to the lyrics is not permitted.
- Participants must bring their own Shruthi boxes
- Duration: 5 Minutes.
- Karaoke is not allowed.

### **2. ROOTS AND RHYTHMS (DANCE) (10.00am to 12.00pm)**

**NOTE: THERE WILL BE NO CHANGES IN THE LOT ASSIGNED TO EACH TEAM**

#### **a) SOLO: BHARATANATYAM**

- Duration: 3 minutes
- The Attire should be proper.
- Cine songs are not allowed
- The Audio recording should be submitted one-hour before the program starts.

#### **b) GROUP: FOLK DANCE**

- Duration: 6 minutes
- The group must not exceed five members
- The attire should be proper.
- The Audio recording should be submitted one hour before the program starts.
- Props can be used

### **3.VEDIC VIBES (SLOKA) (11.00am to 12.00pm)**

- Participants should prepare Shiva Puranam, Mahishasuramardhini sloka.
- Judge will initiate any of the given slokas

### **4. INSTRUMENTAL (Solo or Group) (10.00am to 11.00am)**

- Participants are asked to play only Carnatic songs.
- Participants must bring their own instruments.
- Each school is allowed to participate with up to 3 teams
- Duration: 5 minutes.

### **5.FINGERTIP FANTASY (NAIL ART) (11.00am to 12.30pm)**

- Participants must bring their own materials.
- Participants must work in pair
- Duration: 1hours 30minutes.

### **6. BATTLE OF BRAINS (QUIZ) (10.00am to 12.00pm)**

- Each team shall have 2 members
- Each school is allowed to participate with 2 teams
- Questions from various genres will be proposed
- Teams will advance to subsequent rounds based on their performance.

## **CATEGORY 3: CLASS IX to XII**

- Duration: Maximum 5 Minutes.
- Karaoke is not allowed.

- Topic will be given on the spot.
- Poem should be in written form.
- Poem should not be copied from any other sources.

- Based on your physical fitness, you will be awarded.
